We mark Tu B'Shevat, the New Year for Trees, by eating fruit, particularly from the kinds that are singled out by the Torah in its praise of the bounty of the Holy Land: grapes, figs, pomegranates, nuts, olives, dates and more. On this day we remember that, "man is a tree of the field" (Deuteronomy 20:19), and reflect on the actions we can take to help our ecology. The Kabbalist of Tsfat, Israel of the 16th Century created a Tu B'Shevat Seder, loosely modelled on the Pesach seder, drinking 4 cups

of wine, eating foods that are symbolic of the holiday.

Please come and join us at this fun packed, and enlightening seder.

Children and adults if you wish, please bring along a drawing, painting or model of a tree, and we will have an exhibition.
